Stamford Cradle to Career (SC2C) is seeking caregivers of young children living in Stamford, CT to serve as Parent Ambassadors. The Parent Ambassadors will work with SC2C's Community Engagement Manager, 0-5 Early Childhood Community Action Network and partner organizations to build parent membership within SC2C. The Parent Ambassadors will serve as a "go-to" for families in the community that they serve by conducting outreach activities to identify caregivers of children, prenatal-age 8, and connect them to the SC2C and community resources. The Parent Ambassadors will also attend regional and CT state parent meetings to share local Stamford information and bring back regional and state information relevant to families with young children.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in relevant training opportunities
- Identify and conduct outreach in Stamford to caregivers of young children as well as the broader community
- Connect disconnected families to early learning opportunities, programs, and resources
- Complete monthly reports to track activity and outcomes
- Incorporate parent voice and feedback into decision-making through attendance and participation at SC2C, Leadership Team and/or staff meetings
- Attend regional and state early childhood parent meetings (no more than quarterly)
- Potential to serve as a liaison to the CT Office of Early Childhood's Parent Cabinet (limited positions for this opportunity available)
- Other tasks as assigned

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a caregiver of young children (mother, father, grandparent, foster parent, etc.)
- Must live in Stamford
- Knowledge of the mission of SC2C
- Ability to work collaboratively with diverse populations; establish and maintain positive working relationships
